The procedures include joint resurfacing as an alternative to total knee or hip replacement, robotic and computer-assisted knee replacement and hip arthroscopy. NYHQ is also leveraging newer techniques to treat stubborn injuries, such as platelet-rich plasma (PRP) therapy.
