



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The Cardiac Arrhythmia Program

The Cardiac Arrhythmia Center, an integral part of The New York Hospital Queens Heart & Vascular Center is a unique Cardiac Electrophysiology program in Queens. The Center offers early diagnosis and care to patients with heart rhythm disorders as well as to those at risk for sudden death. The Center also provides follow-up services for patients requiring extended cardiac rhythm monitoring and implanted devices (pacemakers and defibrillators). We offer a remote device follow-up program that provides the patient with greater flexibility. This advanced technology enables the patient to “stay connected” via a phone line no matter where they are. In addition, the Cardiac Arrhythmia Center administers specialized programs for the evaluation and treatment of patients with atrial fibrillation and syncope (blackout spells).
