



As the Heart Hospital of Queens, our goal is to ensure that you have access to the latest technology for your patients, right here in Queens.

Our non-invasive cardiology services at New York Hospital Queens provide the most sophisticated cardiac imaging techniques available today for the diagnosis and treatment of cardiovascular disease. The latest advances in imaging technology provide you with more detailed and accurate information in the diagnosis of diseases such as coronary artery disease, valvular heart disease, and cardiomyopathy.

Cardiac MRI, a three-dimensional imaging technique, is used to study the structure and function of the heart, valves, major vessels, and surrounding structures (such as the pericardium). Additionally we can evaluate the effects of coronary artery disease and assess for myocardial viability following myocardial infarction.

The NYHQ Heart & Vascular Center is the only facility in Queens with **CT Angiography** using the most advanced technology dual-source 64 slice CT scanner. Coronary CTA (“multi-detector” or “multi-slice” CT scan) can identify coronary

plaque and stenosis as well as identify other coronary and vascular anomalies.

Nuclear Cardiac Stress Testing studies evaluate cardiac function, and blood flow, and are a powerful tool used to assess a patient’s prognosis and future risk of myocardial infarction and death.

Transesophageal Echocardiography, performed in our ICAL-certified laboratory, uses an ultrasound transducer to provide clear pictures of cardiac structure and function and is available to cardiologists as an essential tool in assessing entities such as valvular heart disease and etiology of stroke.

The faculty in our non-invasive cardiology laboratories work collaboratively with cardiologists in our community, assessing which of these and many other tests available are most appropriate for a specific patient. If you have a case that you’d like to discuss, we can talk by phone, meet you in the hospital, or visit your office if that’s most convenient.
