At New York Hospital Queens we offer a range of treatment options for patients, including conservative non-surgical, medication, and surgical options for each condition as appropriate.

Conservative treatments:

- Pelvic floor behavioral therapy

- Placement of pessary
- Urethral bulking for management of stress urinary incontinence
- Bladder neuromodulation

Surgical treatments:

- Vaginal reconstructive surgery
- Abdominal reconstructive surgery
- Laparoscopic (minimally invasive) reconstructive surgery
- Pubovaginal slings
- Sacral nerve stimulation
- Robotic-assisted laparoscopic surgery
