Dr. Wang specializes in robotic surgery using the *da Vinci*® Surgical System with expertise in cancers of the genitourinary tract. With the addition of Dr. Wang, New York Hospital Queens continues to expand the clinical leadership team to provide greater access to cutting-edge therapeutics such as robotic surgery.

Dr. Wang performs robotic surgery with the hospital's *da Vinci*® Si Surgical System, the most advanced robotic surgical platform available. He specializes in the treatment of urologic cancers including those of the prostate, bladder, kidney and testis.

Dr. Wang received his Bachelor of Science degree in Molecular Biophysics & Biochemistry from Yale University. He earned his M.D. degree from the Stanford University School of Medicine and then completed his residency training in urology at the NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital–Weill Cornell Medical College and Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. After finishing his urologic residency, he then completed a highly specialized fellowship in urologic oncology and robotic surgery at the NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital–Weill Cornell Medical College. Dr. Wang is Assistant Professor of Clinical Urology at Weill Cornell and a member of the American Urological Association and the Society for Laparoendoscopic Surgeons.

He has presented extensively at international urologic meetings and has won several awards, most notably for his research in robotic surgery. Dr. Wang sits on the review panel for a number of national and international urologic journals. He was the recipient of the prestigious Ferdinand C. Valentine Research Fellowship by the New York Academy of Medicine and the American Urological Association for his work in bladder cancer research. He is noted for publishing a seminal paper on the role of robotic surgery for removal of the bladder in invasive bladder cancer. He is conversant in Mandarin and Spanish.

Dr. Wang is a member of CRT Surgical Associates, the surgical services group at NYHQ.
